A friendly reminder from your Fire Department: Please ensure your chimneys are cleaned regularly and replace the batteries in your smoke detectors to ensure they are working properly.

Turn on Frost Protection Devices

If you haven't done so yet - Frost protection devices (bleeders and heat traces) should now be activated again. Bleeders should only have a small trickle of water going through. The suggested flow rate is 1/8 of a gallon per minute for a properly insulated waterline.

Please note that the Village of Mayo Staff will repair bleeders that are leaking. If you have a problem with your bleeder, please call the Village Office.

Winter Safety

Winter is in full swing and with it snow, ice and slippery roads. Motorists are urged to drive carefully and according to the road and weather conditions. Be sure to check your vehicle lights, and wear reflective clothing or take a flash light if you are out walking or biking. It is important to see and be seen during our dark Yukon nights.
